Remarks:

1. In 4p, “p” stands for “periods” (45 minutes lessons).
2. Subjects can be offered only if a minimum of 5 pupils are enrolled.
3. It is not possible to change a subject or a complementary course between S6 and S7.
4. The minimum number of periods is 31.
5. The upper limit of 35 periods per week can be exceeded only if:
 - a. The total number of periods from the choices No 1 to 6 are precisely 34, you can add one complementary course from No 7.
 - b. You have chosen Math 5p, plus two 4p science subjects, you are allowed to have 36 periods altogether.
6. In order to be admitted to a 4p option, you need to have taken the subject already in S4 and S5.
7. Pupils must take a minimum of two options (No 3). It is however strongly advised to take three options in order to have a choice of written examinations in the baccalaureate examination.
